## Responsibilities:

- To educate visitors on the history, nature, and resources within the parks and answer questions visitors may have
- Enforce leave-no-trace policies and ensure the parks are being respected and protected
- Presenting educational and interpretive programming

Where would you live: Big city areas, rural areas all across the country

Salary # of jobs: **\$30,000 - \$40,000 a year** Jobs are very competitive, and openings often are only available to current federal employees

Estimated growth: -3%
