However, if your program's Director of Graduate Studies is a member of your thesis or dissertation committee or is out of town, your Department Chair or Program Director should serve as the proxy. The proxy should sign his or her name followed by "for (committee member)." Please note that the committee chair may not serve as the proxy.
