Interweaving Verbal, Visual and Tactile Spaces: Andean Textile Imagery in the Works of Two 20th-Century Latin American Poets

This talk explores the interface of Andean textile construction and design in the poetry and the artwork of two Latin American poet-artists, Jorge Eduardo Eielson (Peru, 1924-2006) and Cecilia Vicuña (Chile, 1948). Professor Clark's research shows how weaving crosses over into the realms of visual and verbal texts thus supplementing these artistic zones with optical and tactile planes of meaning.
