

POSITIONS AVAILABLE: PSYCHOMETRIST/LICENSED PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSOCIATE (F/T)

The University of Kentucky College of Medicine, Department of Neurology, Division of Neuropsychology, is recruiting full-time Licensed Psychological Associates. Employees will work as part of an integrated team, conducting neuropsychological assessments for patients across the lifespan. This service is an integral component of the Neurology, Neurosurgery, and Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation departments at UK HealthCare and receives additional referrals from over two dozen UK service lines and regional healthcare systems.

UK HealthCare/University of Kentucky is a 1,173-bed tertiary/quaternary medical center, ranked No. 1 on the Best Regional Hospitals list for Kentucky and the Bluegrass Region by U.S. News & World Report. Additionally, the Stroke Center at Kentucky Neuroscience Institute is designated as a Comprehensive Stroke Center by The Joint Commission and is the recipient of the American Heart Association Gold Plus Quality Achievement Award and the Target Stroke Honor Roll Elite Plus Award. The Kentucky Neuroscience Institute is also a Level 4 Epilepsy Center, the highest designation by the National Association of Epilepsy Centers, and is designated as a Center for Comprehensive Care by the National MS Society, underscoring the excellence of our facilities and the expertise of our neuropsychology providers. UK HealthCare's neuropsychology division includes world-renowned academic clinicians with research appointments in Kentucky Neuroscience Institute, the UK Spinal Cord & Brain Injury Research Center, and the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging, one of the world's leading centers on the science of aging.

The University of Kentucky College of Medicine is centrally located in beautiful downtown Lexington, KY, "The Horse Capital of the World." Residents enjoy simultaneous access to vibrant downtown amenities and country comforts.
