Please attach to your e-mail message the following files:

- 1.) A paper that you consider to be your best work in a sociology course.
- 2.) A research proposal clearly delineating your research question(s). You should include a concise statement of your problem: what puzzling phenomenon, or case, or what sorts of relationships are you going to explore, and why should anyone in Sociology care? Your discussion should include at least three important articles or books in sociology that speak to your question(s). Discuss the method you plan to use and why your approach is best suited for answering your particular questions. You may refine your questions and method approach early in the fall semester, but data collection should begin by the end of fall semester, if not sooner, leaving the spring semester for final data collection and analysis.
