

Enroll in Graduate-level Course for Undergraduate Credit Form For School of Business, Education, Law, or Marine Science

Undergraduate students at William & Mary may take graduate-level courses (numbered 500 and above) for credit toward the bachelor's degree, provided:

- Student has a GPA of at least 2.5 overall and 3.0 in the subject field of the course
- Student has taken the appropriate prerequisites
- Material in the graduate-level course is relevant to the student's program and is not available in the undergraduate curriculum

Instructions

- 1. Complete one form for each graduate course.
- 2. Obtain the instructor's signature.
- 3. Obtain the signature of that school's Dean.
- 4. Attach a copy of your DegreeWorks.
- 5. Return completed form to the Assistant Dean for Undergraduate Education, Ewell Hall.

Deadline: The completed form (with DegreeWorks) is due before the end of Add/Drop.

If the petition is approved, the Registrar's Office will send a notification of enrollment in the course.
