

BA, International Honours checklist

St Andrews credits = 4 x W&M credits; (W&M credit totals in parentheses)

General	◇ Achieve 480 StA (120 W&M) credits after 4 years ◇ Achieve 120 StA (30 W&M) credits per year
Sub-Honours (1 st & 2 nd years)	○ Achieve 240 (60) credits by end of 2nd year, with 2nd year modules/classes demonstrating progression (at St Andrews, this means a minimum of 80 (20) credits at 2000/200 level). ○ Pass all sub-honours modules/classes that are required for your major. ○ Pass a COLL 150: W&M Home students should take a COLL 150 in their first year; St Andrews Home students should take a COLL in their first semester of second year. ○ Achieve breadth requirements and proficiencies.
Honours (3 rd & 4 th years)	○ Achieve 240 (60) credits across 3rd and 4th year, normally taking 120 (30) credits in each year. In your Major subject: ○ Achieve 180 (45) credits in the Major subject at 300/3000 and 400/4000 level, across the two Honours years (this does NOT include any 300/400 level taken at W&M in 1st or 2nd year – they <i>will not</i> count towards this requirement) ○ At least 90 (22.5) credits taken in the Major must be at 4000-level in the Major subject, across the two Honours years (all W&M 400-level, and some W&M 300-level count for this but, again: any 300/400 level taken in 1st or 2nd year do NOT count) Across all modules/classes taken during honours: ○ Achieve a minimum of 210 (52.5) Honours-level credits (3000/300 level or 4000/400 level) across all modules/classes, including those in your major subject. ○ Take no more than 30 (7.5) credits at 100/200 level at W&M across the two Honours years.
