

Business Minor Academic Pathways for JDP Students

This document outlines the academic pathway for completing the Accounting Minor under the constraint that only BUAD 203 can be taken before admission. Students may apply to the minor in the semester in which they will be completing 39 credit hours (typically at the end of their second year). After admission, all remaining minor courses must be completed in one academic year.

Notes on Sequencing and Options

Start with BUAD 301 after admission. BUAD 301 is a prerequisite for BUAD 302

Before Admissions (Years 1-2)

- Take only BUAD 203 – Principles of Accounting (3 cr.) during Year 1 or 2.
- Reach ≥ 39 credits by end of Year 2 and apply to the business minor.

After Admissions (Years 3-4)

Fall

1. BUAD 301 – Financial Reporting and Analysis (3 cr.) *Note 301 is a prereq for 302*
2. Elective A (3 cr.)
3. Elective B (3 cr.)

Only offered in the Fall: BUAD 303 and 401; 304 every other year

Spring

4. BUAD 301 – Financial Reporting and Analysis (3 cr.) *Note 301 is a prereq for 302*
5. Elective A (3 cr.)
6. Elective B (3 cr.)

Only offered in the Fall: BUAD 303 and 401; 304 every other year
