This document outlines the academic pathway for completing the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Minor. Students may apply to the minor in the semester in which they are completing 39 credit hours (typically at the end of their second year). After admission, all minor courses must be completed in one academic year.

Notes on Sequencing and Options

Before Admissions (Years 1 or 2)

- Reach ≥ 39 credits by end of Year 2 and apply to the business minor.
- BUAD 340 (required): Intro to Innovation & Entrepreneurship
- Choose 1 from the following
 - ART 211 (elective) - Drawing & Color
 - ART 212 (elective) - Three-dimensional design
 - BUAD 457 (elective): Creative Problem Solving (with permission)

After Admissions (Years 3 or 4)

Fall

1. BUAD 443: Entrepreneurial Ventures (fall only)
2. BUAD 451: Customer Insights for Innovation (fall only)

Spring

3. BUAD 453: Sustainability Inspired Design (spring only)
4. Choose 1 from the following:
 - a. ART 211 (elective) - Drawing & Color
 - b. ART 212 (elective) - Three-dimensional design
- BUAD 457 (elective): Creative Problem Solving (with permission)
