CAMPUS SAFETY



- Do not allow strangers to follow you into a building. Authorized staff and guests will have cards that provide them access.
- Never prop open residence hall doors.
- Never leave valuable items unattended.
- Notify your group leader or C&E Services if there is a stranger in your building. Staff will have visible identification cards or uniforms.
- Lock all doors and windows before leaving your room.
- Report any suspicious activity to C&E Services.

CAMPUS POLICE



In the event of an emergency, call 911.

The W&M Police Department is a Virginia-certified police department responsible for providing the full range of law enforcement and other unique services to the University community.

FIRE SAFETY



In case of fire...

1. Pull the nearest alarm.
2. Exit the building, alerting others as you go. Evacuation maps are posted on every floor.
3. Call 911 to report the fire.
4. Gather at a predetermined muster point.
5. Do NOT re-enter the building until told to do so by police or fire department.

CAMPUS POLICIES

- Do NOT tamper with emergency blue light call stations.
- Do NOT tamper with fire safety equipment. (e.g. fire extinguishers, pull stations)
- Do not smoke in the building .
- Do not play sports inside the building.
- Do not store bicycles or scooters inside residence halls.
- NO open flames, fireworks, explosives, highly flammable materials, or extension cords.
- Signs/banners may not be affixed to walls, windows, doors, fences, or trees.
- Animals not allowed in residence halls (except for service animals).

LOCKOUTS

If you are locked out of your room, call our office. We will be there as quickly as possible. After office hours, please give us ~2 hours to arrive.
