

W&M D.C. Summer Session Cost to Students

The cost for students to attend one D.C. Summer Session course is:

- Standard Summer Session tuition and fees for **three credits** ([since the cost per credit hour changes year-to-year, please check here for current rates](#))
 - 2021-2022 rates:
 - In-State \$581/credit hour
 - Out-of-State \$1,336/credit hour
 - Non-refundable one-time registration fee of \$25
 - Non-refundable one-time comprehensive fee of \$55

Housing Cost:

For those students who do not live locally in D.C., Northern Virginia or Maryland areas, there is the option of discounted hotel rates for the dates of your mandatory in-person class sessions.

Additional Expenses:

The average cost per student varies; however, most students report spending between \$125 - \$175 per week on groceries, metro, and other personal expenses (excludes lodging, travel and parking fees).

Financial Aid:

Currently enrolled and matriculated W&M students can take out student loans, private loans, or their parents can take out a PLUS Loan, to cover the cost of DC Summer Session. Students must complete a FAFSA form to apply for loans. Students must also complete a Summer Aid Application.
