- As a student employee, intern, and/or volunteer in the Dean of Students Office, I understand that I will be working with sensitive and confidential information.

- I understand that I am potentially subjecting the University to litigation for violation of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act if I break the confidentiality of this office. If I violate any of the above, I will be held accountable by the University Student Conduct system for failure to comply with directions of a College official. I understand that I may be subject to dismissal from my position if I have violated any of the above.
