Decal No. 5: WARNING – body positioning (located on outside right-hand corner of platform) f. Decal No. 6: CAUTION: Spring tension (located on upright next to the torsion spring and safety holder) g. Decal No. 7: WARNING – lift gate equipment/use (located on front of the control shield) h. Decal No. 8: Lift Rating (located on the front of the control shield) i. Decal No. 9: DANGER – box cover removal (located on box cover of gate) j. Decal No. 10: k. Decal No. 11: Dos & Do Nots (located in cab in highly visible area) 	YES	NO
