Please describe your payment plans, if provided:

Members can choose between 3 payment plans: monthly, semesterly, or yearly. Changes to this plan can be made any time at the members' convenience. All new members are required to sign a Dues & Fees Contract acknowledging their commitment to fulfill their financial obligations to the Fraternity. Returning members must sign the Dues & Fees Contract for each upcoming academic year by August 1st.

For new and initiated members opting for a yearly plan, members pay fall and spring semester dues at one



time, due on October 1st for new members and August 1st for initiated members. Similarly, for a semesterly plan, the full semester amounts will be due on October 1st for new members and August 1st for initiated members. In the spring, the full semesterly amount will be due January 1st. For new members opting for a monthly payment plan, the billed amount will be due by the first of each month, October through May. For initiated members, the billed amount will be due by the first of each month, August through May.

All members have the option to confidentially discuss with Standards Team options for payment plans that differ from those listed above (e.g., 11-monthly rather than 9-monthly; change of due date from 1st to 10th or equivalent, etc). Members can also speak with Standards Team to apply for Academic Professional Status, Excused Status, or Study Abroad status which have a set reduction on the dues amount a member pays.

Please describe scholarship options for new and current members, if provided:

Delta Gamma Executive Offices offers merit-based scholarship opportunities through an application process. Some scholarships are available internationally to members across all chapters, some are region-specific, and one is designated specifically for the Epsilon Mu Chapter. Applications typically open in January and close in March, with recipients notified in July. Need-based scholarships are also available through a rolling application process.

Sorority residency requirements:

All 16 spots must be filled. All members who have completed their freshman year at William & Mary may volunteer to live in the chapter house; however, our chapter uses a housing point system, which is determined by membership and leadership involvement (i.e. points given to members for each semester in the chapter and to those who hold Panhellenic officer or chapter management positions). If more members apply than there are available spaces, housing assignments are offered to applicants with the highest number of housing points. If the chapter house is not filled through the application process, the Director of House Management may assign members to live in the house through a lottery system. In this case, members with the highest housing point totals are the last to be selected. The only chapter position that requires residence in the chapter house is the Director of House Management.

All Sorority Housing is owned and operated by Residence Life. The per-term cost includes room, deposit, wireless internet, and air conditioning. Housing costs for the 2026-2027 academic year are set by Residence Life. Sorority housing is billed at the standard double room rate, which can be found on the William & Mary Residence Life website.

What fees may a member encounter that are separate from dues and fees billed by your chapter?

The standard anchor badge is included in membership dues (valued at \$55), but if a member wishes to upgrade to an alternate style, they may do so by paying the difference in cost. Apparel purchases, with the exception of recruitment and Anchor Games shirts, are optional and are not included in chapter dues. There are typically 1-3 merchandise sales per semester with items usually ranging from \$20-\$65. Members participating as a "Big" during Big-Little Clue Week often spend approximately \$100 on gifts and activities; however, spending is at the member's discretion. Live out members are billed an \$80 housing fee each year. New members are also billed a one-time fee of \$150 to become a member of House Corporation. The Epsilon Mu chapter of Delta Gamma does not fine members.
