**Please describe your payment plans, if provided:**

Phi Mu charges certain fees on a specific schedule dictated by Phi Mu Fraternity Headquarters. The fees charged per month vary by membership type. New members are charged the total cost in 3 installments beginning the month after Bid Day. The fee breakdowns for new members is \$270.00 (month 1), \$367.00 (month 2), and \$190.00 (month 3). Initiated members are billed the total cost split in 4 installments per semester. New members only pay new member dues for their first semester in the chapter. After the first semester, initiated member dues are charged. Members cannot pay a full semester's worth of dues up front.

All members pay online through BillHighway. Bills are issued on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month and are due by the 10<sup>th</sup> with no late fees applied. BillHighway automatically applies a 3% late fee per item to bills paid after the 10<sup>th</sup> of a month; Phi Mu has no control over the cost or number of late fees. Members who fail to pay bills on time without communication will be referred to the Honor Council for assistance.

Members studying abroad or taking a break from full membership due to extenuating circumstances may elect to go on ICMS (Interim Collegiate Membership Status). They will be billed the Study Abroad Membership Dues, but will not be allowed to participate in full membership activities (chapter meetings, social events, etc.).

**Please describe scholarship options for new and current members, if provided:**

Phi Mu at William & Mary offers 3 \$100 scholarships per semester. One scholarship is specifically for a new member, the second scholarship is for an initiated member, and the third scholarship is for general need. Additionally, the Phi Mu Foundation provides need and merit-based scholarships to collegiate members. All scholarships are application-based.

**Sorority residency requirements:**

Phi Mu's chapter house has 11 spots that must be filled. Members apply to live in the house. If all spots are not filled after the application deadline, then a lottery is held by ascending social class to fill the remaining vacant spots. If members have binding housing contracts (ex. apartment lease), then they are not required to live in the house.

All Sorority Housing is owned and operated by Residence Life. The per-term cost includes room, deposit, wireless internet, and air conditioning. Housing costs for the 2026-2027 academic year are set by Residence Life. Sorority housing is billed at the standard double room rate, which can be found on the William & Mary Residence Life website

**What fees may a member encounter that are separate from dues and fees billed by your chapter?**

Members of Phi Mu may optionally order merchandise, but this is paid for by individual members and is not required. Phi Mu Clue Week is three days, with initiated members limited to \$50 per day for big-little gifts if they choose to take a little sister. Fines are applied for repeated unexcused absences from mandatory events but can be appealed. Late fees are automatically applied by BillHighway.
