Please describe your payment plans, if provided:

Pi Beta Phi HQ offers a three-payment plan each semester for any member who wishes to pay their dues in installments. There is no financial requirement or pre-approval process for obtaining a payment plan. Members on payment plans pay one-third of their dues on September 30, one-third on October 31, and the remaining third on November 30 (using fall semester as an example). Payments must be made on or before their due date. Otherwise, the plan is voided, and the full amount must be paid in full as soon as possible. Our chapter's Vice President of Finance and Housing can discuss alternative payment plans for members with extenuating financial circumstances.

Please describe scholarship options for new and current members, if provided:

Our chapter encourages members and PNMs to explore all opportunities for scholarships. The Pi Beta Phi Foundation has created over 100 scholarships for undergraduate members to apply for that open November 15 each year. HQ also has a grant program members can apply for in times of unexpected financial hardship. Our chapter's Director of Academics also regularly announces and promotes scholarship opportunities from Pi Beta Phi HQ, the state of Virginia, and other organizations Pi Phi supports.

Sorority residency requirements:

All 14 spots in the chapter house must be filled. All new members sign a contract before initiation agreeing to live in the chapter house if selected and if they have not already signed a lease. Eligible members are then selected by lottery to live in the chapter house if demand exceeds the number of rooms. If there are not enough members to fill the chapter house, the Finance & Housing Team will randomly pull an eligible member to fill the empty space in the house.

All Sorority Housing is owned and operated by Residence Life. The per-term cost includes room, deposit, wireless internet, and air conditioning. Housing costs for the 2026-2027 academic year are set by Residence Life. Sorority housing is billed at the standard double room rate, which can be found on the William & Mary Residence Life website.

What fees may a member encounter that are separate from dues and fees billed by your chapter?

The Virginia Gamma Chapter of Pi Beta Phi functions on a "points-based" system, this means that no member will be fined additional charges for missing mandatory events (ex. recruitment, chapter, initiation). None of our chapter-sponsored events will have additional fees. Costs members may incur outside of dues include spending for big/little Clue Week, optional merchandise and apparel, and clothing for formal events or recruitment.
