This document will cover downloading and installing the SecureW2 certificate installer for Eduroam. **Because each Android version is different, images and menus may be different.**


1. Download and install the SecureW2 JoinNow application

Choose your role.



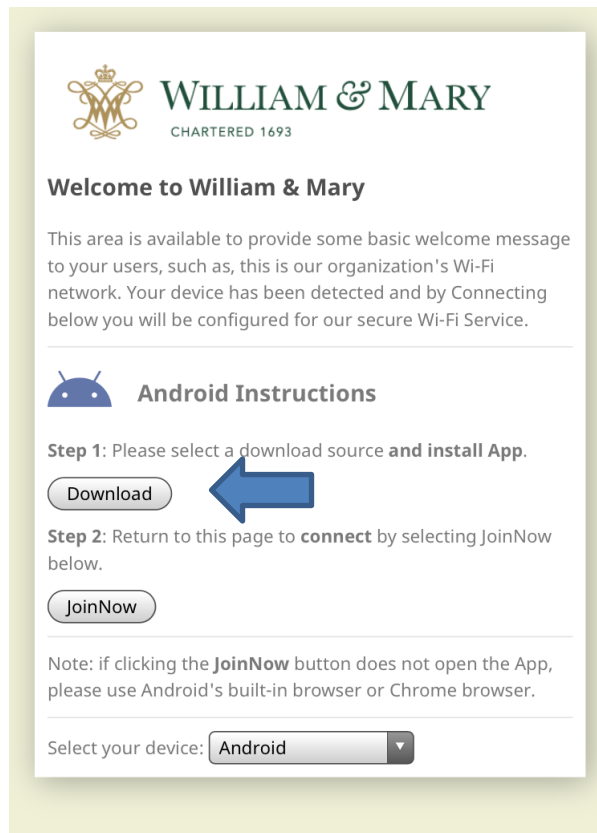

Campus visitors may connect for 24 hours and request further access from a W&M sponsor.

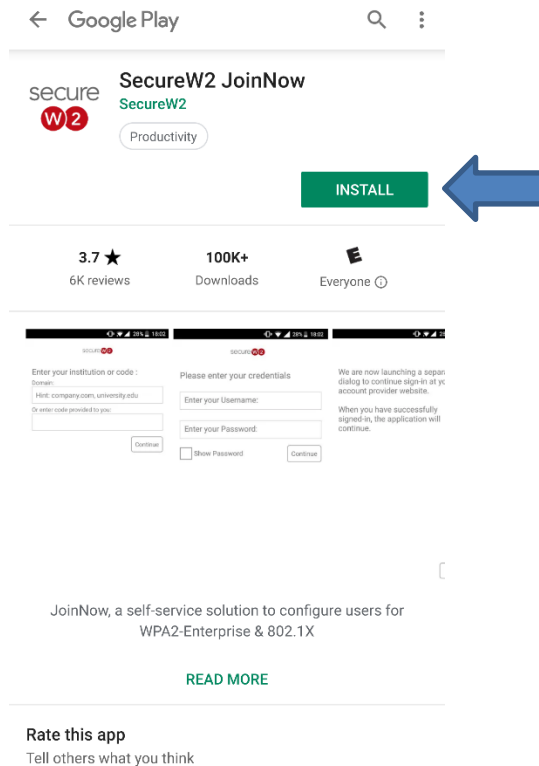

Choose 'Download Configuration App'



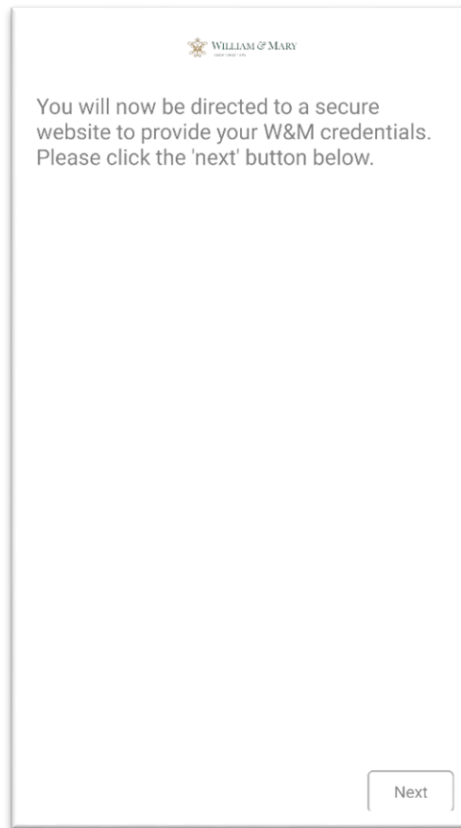
Install 'SecureW2 JoinNow'



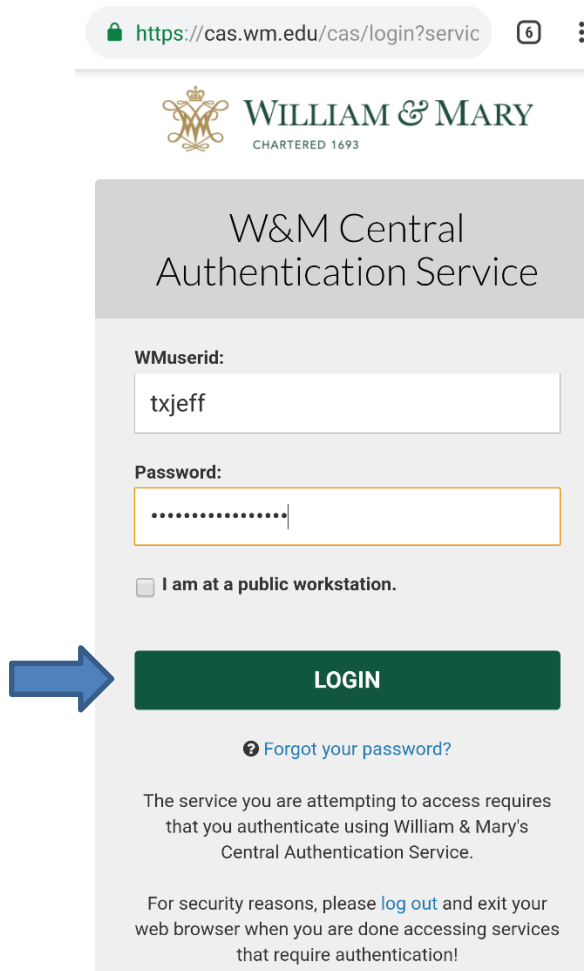
Install the Eduroam Certificate

Once downloaded, the application will automatically open.
(If the application does not open automatically, visit <https://connect.wm.edu> from Chrome and click the 'Install Network Configuration' button.)

Click **Next**



Enter your Banner (CAS) credentials. Click login.
