Downloading the View Client

- In a browser window, go to <https://vdesktop.wm.edu/>
- Click on the link to download the client appropriate for your system.

Android and iOS (iPad, iPhone) VMWare View clients are also available via the appropriate app stores.



You must use View Client for Windows to access this Connection Server.

To connect, start the View Client and enter `vdesktop.wm.edu` as the server address.

If the Client is not installed, you may download it from the link below.

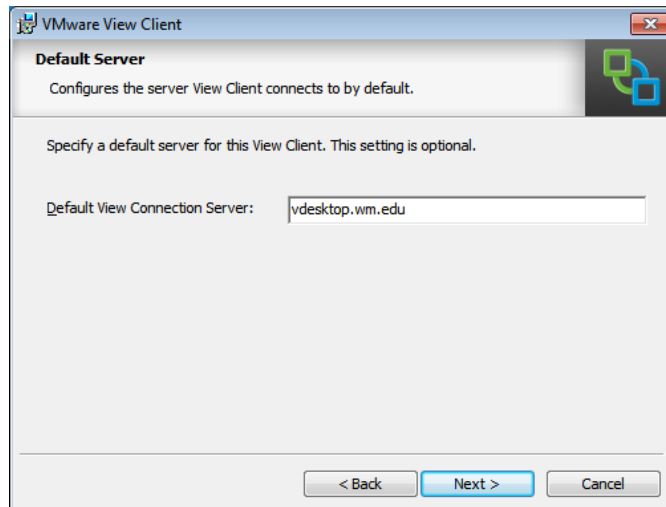

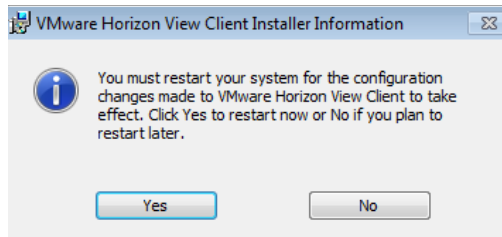
Installing the View Client

- Run the installer program you downloaded, providing administrative credentials as necessary and accepting all the defaults.
- When asked to provide a default View Connection Server, indicate **vdesktop.wm.edu**








(example from a Windows installation)

- Continue selecting defaults, and reboot when your system when prompted.
- The View Client will be installed on your system with a shortcut in your Start Menu and on your Desktop.

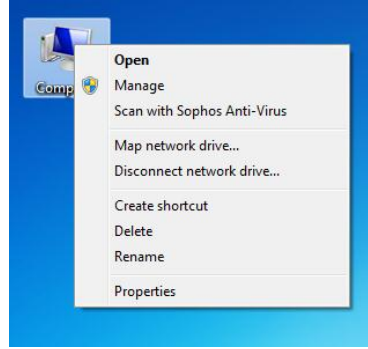


Starting the View Client

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After restarting your system, you are now ready to start the VMWare View Client. • Once the Client has started, Click Connect. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When prompted for a user name and password, use your WMUserid and Password. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Choose the Virtual Desktop you would like to connect to, then select Connect. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Display option at the bottom allows you to choose the size you want your Virtual Desktop to appear. 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It may take several minutes to connect to you Virtual Desktop. • Once connected, review the banner information and click OK to consent and log in. 	

Determining Version of Windows

- Right-click Computer and choose Properties



- Next to System type it will tell you either 32-bit or 64-bit Operating System.
- If your system is 32-bit choose View Client for Windows, otherwise choose View Client for Windows X64
