

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



Chart ENR 2.1 Fall Enrollment Trend by Gender: 2008-2022

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
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
Chart ENR 2.2 Fall Enrollment Trend by Residency: 2008-2022








Chart ENR 6.1 Percentage of Racial/ethnic Groups: Fall 2022




Chart ENR 7.2 Top 10 Popular Undergrad Majors VS. Others: Fall 2022

Note: This chart doesn't include Undeclared major.





Chart ENR 15.1 Undergraduate STEM Major Enrollment



