

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



Chart ENR 2.1 Fall Enrollment Trend by Gender: 2008-2023




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Chart ENR 2.2 Fall Enrollment Trend by Residency: 2008-2023



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

Chart ENR 15.1 Undergraduate STEM Major Enrollment







Chart ENR 15.2 Grad/Professional STEM Major Enrollment
