Modern Language Proficiency Exemption Form

Students seeking to demonstrate proficiency in a modern foreign language may do so by documenting one of the following:

- 1) this was the language of instruction in the high school from which you graduated,
- 2) that you have scored "Intermediate" or higher on the ACTFL oral and writing proficiency standardized tests for this language.

If you meet one of these criteria, you may petition the University Registrar for alternate fulfillment of the foreign language proficiency requirement.
