Overview of Plumeri Award

The Plumeri Awards recognize and reward core virtues that distinguish outstanding faculty members and define excellence at William & Mary. Full-time faculty in all schools who have been at W&M for a least five years are eligible for the award, with no restrictions on the number of recipients selected from each school or area.

Nine awardees will be selected every year, each receiving a \$20,000 prize expendable over a three-year period. Faculty members may be selected for the award multiple times, but only once in a five-year period. Refer to award announcement for more details.
