## Equipment Repair:

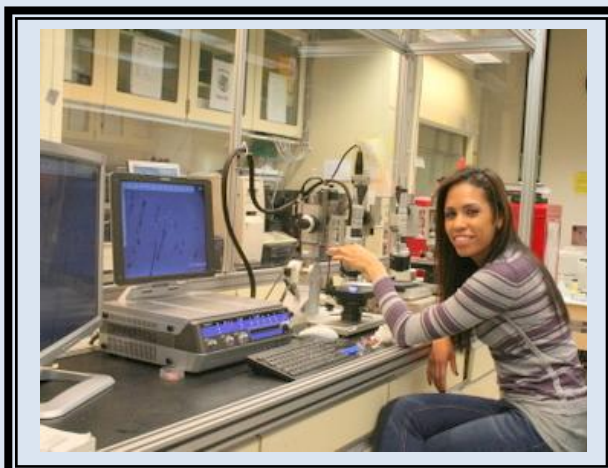
