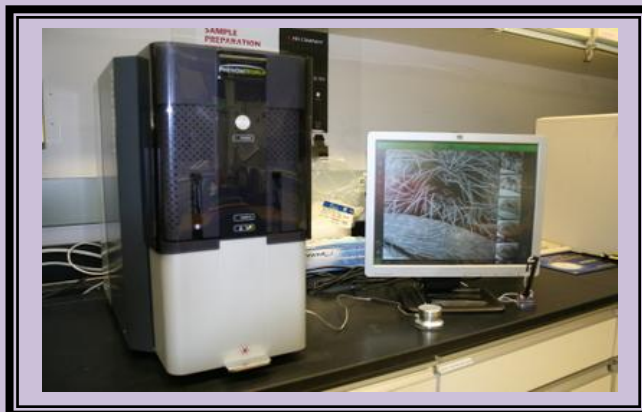


Conference Room 301

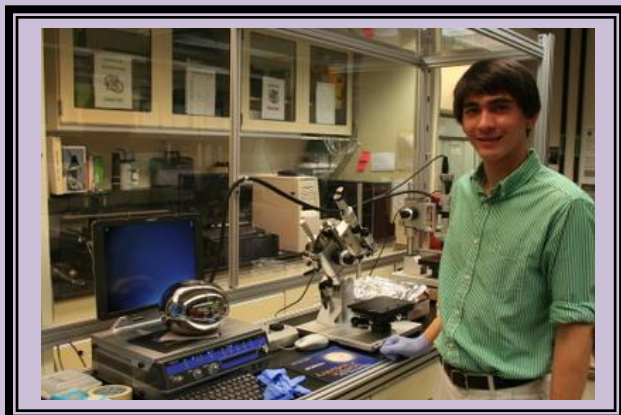
New Tandberg videoconferencing equipment was installed in Conference Room 301 to support online courses and other communication needs.

A new 17 inch touch screen monitor was installed for the Phenom microscope.

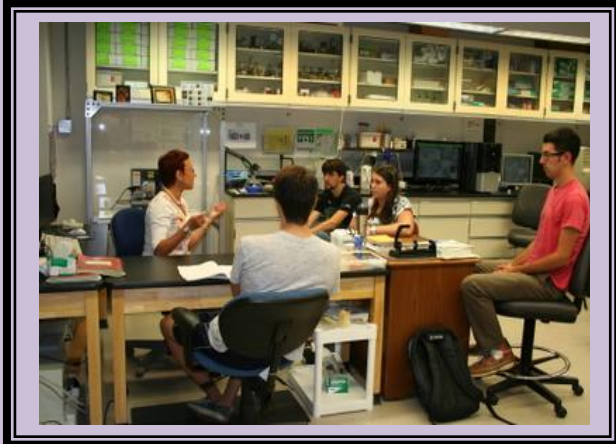


Summer Research:
