



ADVANTAGES

- Requires no redesign for building layout
- Campus Drive need not be realigned
- Campus Drive realignment possible for traffic engineering reasons
- Gas and sanitary force main relocations not necessary
- Building footprint out of ravine
- North roadway out of ravine
- Maintains 65' setback from Jamestown Road
- Setback from Campus Drive consistent with parking deck
- Maintains symmetrical, Georgian plan form
- Provides 10 parallel parking spaces near front door at Morton Lot
- Building footprint minimally impacts woods at west end of site

DISADVANTAGES

- Underground electrical and switch/transformers must be relocated
- Requires removal of 19 large-caliper trees
- Work will affect approximately 27,348 s. f. of woods









NORTH & SOUTH COURTYARD ELEVATION






