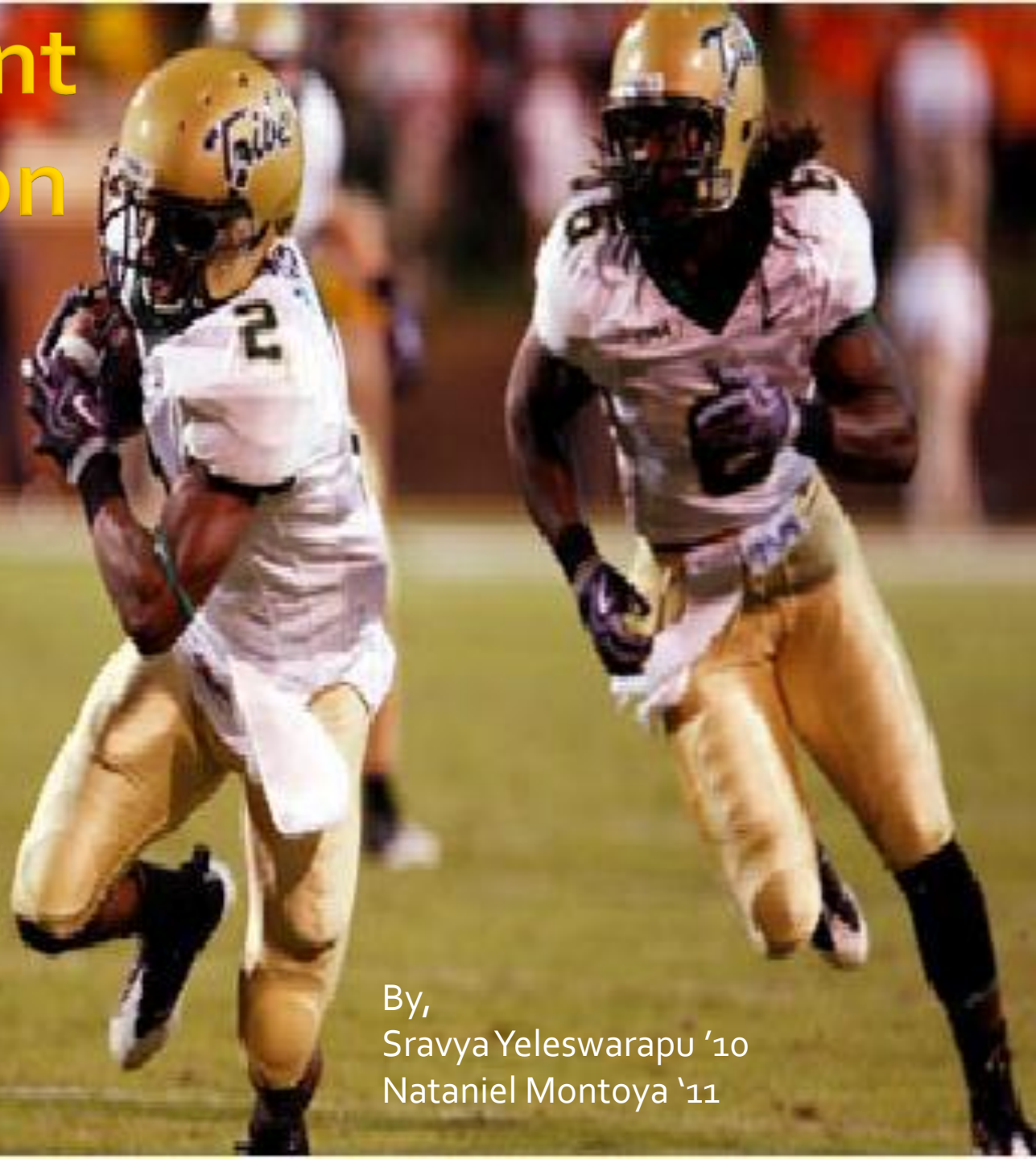


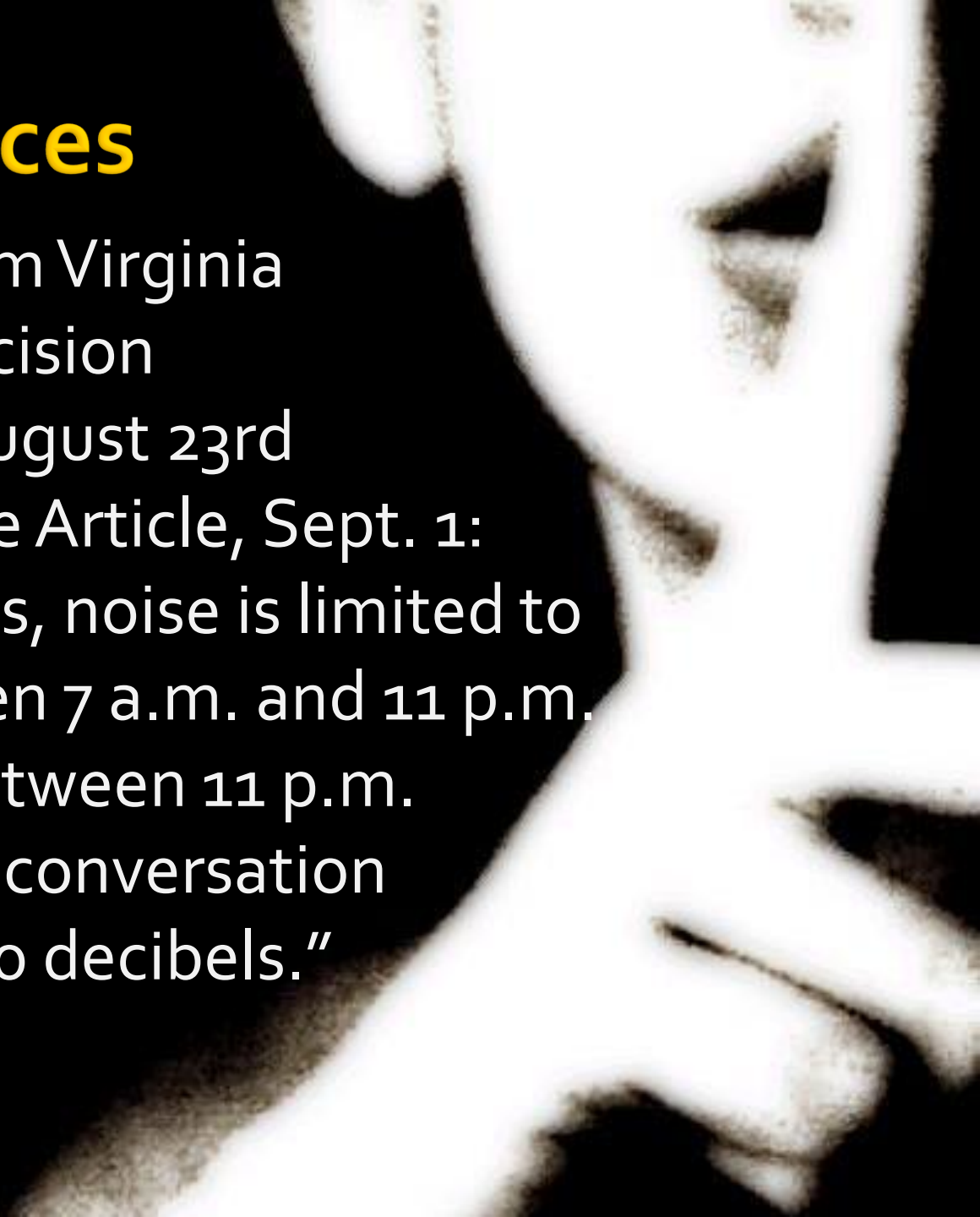

Noise Ordinances

- Law stemming from Virginia Supreme Court decision
- Went into effect August 23rd
- Flat Hat Front Page Article, Sept. 1:
“In residential areas, noise is limited to 65 decibels between 7 a.m. and 11 p.m. and 55 decibels between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Normal conversation averages around 60 decibels.”



Noise Ordinances

- Consequences: class 2 misdemeanor charge (\$300 fine)
- Mistrust between students and city of Williamsburg



Changes in Greek Life

- Students' perception of college policies on fraternity housing creating tensions
- Williamsburg restriction on off-campus houses
- Possible decline in fraternity interest
