Natalie Hall Named Southeast Region Coach of the Year

William and Mary head women's cross country coach [Natalie Hall](#) was named the Southeast Region Coach of the Year on Tuesday, after leading the Tribe to the region championship and an NCAA berth last weekend. Voting on the award was done by the United States Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCCA), which picked an Athlete of the Year and Coach of the Year for both men and women in all nine Division I regions. Hall is the first women's coach in school history to claim the Regional Coach of the Year award.
