







- Approved RBC to offer Business Administration AS degree entirely online effective Fall 2015—a "Substantive Change" to current accreditation
- RBC is now also approved to offer additional online programs

REMOVING BARRIERS TO STUDENT SUCCESS



- Accurate placement testing <u>crucial</u> to timely degree completion
- New placement procedures for ENGLISH
 & MATH
- Both placement procedures reflect current best-practice

ASSESSING COURSES & PROGRAMS



- GOAL MET: All courses now have measurable student learning outcomes
- All courses are scheduled for assessment on rotating schedule
- Assessment of learning outcomes added to annual faculty evaluations

ALIGNING HUMAN RESOURCES WITH MISSION

- NEW FACULTY HIRES: RBC investing in full-time faculty to advance mission & goals and maintain positive FT teaching ratio
- Five new faculty hired for 2015/16
- Searches currently underway for five faculty positions for 2016/17



ALIGNING HUMAN RESOURCES WITH MISSION

- Shared Governance system ensures that faculty have a role in College governance
- Committee structure includes both faculty and staff, increasing efficiency and reducing redundancy of effort
- Committees promote adaptable, continuous improvement across campus




ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Fiscal Year 2012








NUMBER OF STUDENTS AWARDED 571 Total Pell / 307 Full Pell
