

E-FYI Workshops

In collaboration with the Office of First Year Experience, the Center for Student Diversity offers an Essential FYI workshop for first-year students. This workshop is led by upperclass Diversity Peer Educators, who engage students in an interactive discussion of diversity.

As a one-hour workshop, the EFYI workshop is designed to be an introduction to diversity in the William & Mary community that encourages students to both learn from, and set standards of respect for, one another.
