- Scanned issues facing intercollegiate athletics nationally and regionally
- Assessed W&M strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats (SWOT)
- 1,400+ inputs from 500+ student-athletes, 7,500+ external stakeholders,
 130 W&M Athletics and university personnel
- 40+ in-person interviews with senior leadership, athletic department staff, coaches, student athletes and alumni
- Vision, mission, values, and goals presented to Board of Visitors in September 2018 and Foundation Board in October 2018.
