## VI. Committee Reports

Terry encouraged committees to meet regularly.

- a. Administrative Issues Meeting monthly. John Poma came to last meeting. Will come to every other meeting to keep PPFA in the loop with HR projects and plans. Discussed some of the larger projects coming. College is planning to go to 26 pays. Health insurance and health care will not come out of 26 pays; it will come out of 24. This means the net pay will drop per paycheck. This change will negatively affect the lowest paid workers. HR still planning to go ahead with 26 pays despite the issue it creates for staff who may be living pay check to pay check. HR is also looking at Cornerstone modifications. HR is creating a representative campus committee to look at Cornerstone for potential changes. Issue was discovered Goals roll from Performance plan to Performance plan but not to the review. HR will work with Cornerstone for programming changes to move data appropriately. HR is also looking at a new rating scale for performance plans. Another big project for 2018 is upgrade to Banner 9, which is for all modules in Banner and is a college-wide project.
- b. Academic Affairs email meeting only. Will meet to define Professional and Professional Faculty categories and make sure HR understands the difference. HR currently lumping all staff together. PPF Handbook doesn't cover interactions with students like the faculty handbook does. Nothing about amorous relationships. Was suggested that we check with Kristin Boyce about this issue and the College's policy for all staff.
- c. Membership Committee will meet in spring to prepare for elections. Working
  on language to change bi-laws for term assignment for newly elected members.
  Will provide at next meeting for assembly to consider.
