**The Chalk Art Competition Act Part III**

WHEREAS, the Muscarelle Museum of Art is hosting its third annual national Chalk Art competition in late Summer 2023 with the intended return of a W&M recognition/event during the national competition.

WHEREAS, Student Assembly (SA), William & Mary's Office of Student Leadership Development (SLD), Student Transition Engagement Programs (STEP), and Muscarelle Museum of Art are partnering together to host the W&M Chalk Art event at the Crim Dell Corridor on September 2nd or 3rd as part of the national challenge;

WHEREAS, the university designates open events as part of "My First W&M Weekend" in order to support new students finding activities and connections after orientation is completed. This event is well positioned as part of My First W&M Weekend to provide a social outlet for student organizations, halls, and groups of friends to participate together;

WHEREAS, having a beverage station (water) for the Chalk Art event supports hydration for students participating in this community building event;

WHEREAS, sponsors are able to continue the success of the last two years and support festivities such as a DJ for music and ability to make announcements for all participants and upgrade the social aspect of the Chalk Art competition;

WHEREAS, SLD, STEP, and the Muscarelle Museum of Art are co-sponsors of the event and will thus contribute partial funding for the event (covering chalk art supplies and the \$20/team registration fee);

WHEREAS, Student Assembly is also a sponsor of the event and therefore should also provide financial support;

WHEREAS, this will be a community-building event and increase awareness of the Muscarelle Museum of Art.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Approves the allocation of up to \$1300 from the Student Assembly Reserves to fund this initiative:
  - a. \$850 for beverage stations during the competition \$150 for Facilities Management Charges for the rental of 6 tables and 10 chairs
  - b. \$450 for a 4 hour DJ contract
2. Stipulates that any funds not used will be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
