A Bill

*To provide funding for colored flyers and a tabling event for the promotion of flu shots*

**The Flu-B-Gone Act**

Sponsored by Senator Matthew Hwang ('25), Senator Hashir Aqeel ('25), President Yannie Chang ('25), and Senator Hazel Vineet ('25)

WHEREAS, the Student Health Center offers a variety of services that many members of the student body are not aware of;

WHEREAS, one of these vital services is the provision of free flu vaccinations for students on campus;

WHEREAS, the Student Health Center is offering free flu vaccinations to the students who have the school's United Healthcare insurance while the school provides 4 free vaccination clinics on October 9th, 19th, 26th, and 30th at Sadler Center for students, faculty, and staff who have private insurance;

WHEREAS, the Student Health Center partners with the Prescription Shoppe to run the clinics;

WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommends those ages 6 months and older receive a flu shot in order to lessen the impact of flu season;

WHEREAS, influenza activity often increases in October, peaking in February, and can last as late as May;

WHEREAS, the 327th and 330th Student Assembly has previously supported the efforts for the advertisement and promotion of free flu shots at the Campus Health Center;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates \$100 for the printing of colored flyers to advertise the Student Health Center's availability of free flu shots for students who have UHCSR insurance and the flu shot clinics for students without UHCSR insurance
  - a. The Flyer's Design (VIA W&M Health Promotion Department)
2. Charges the sponsors of the bill to distribute the finalized design of all graphic material to the Student Assembly (via Slack and other official avenues) for general approval before printing
3. Charges the sponsors of this bill to design the flyers, posters for A-frames in SA possession, and social media graphics for the advertisement and promotion of flu shot availability.

a. Social Media Graphics

4. Charges the sponsors of the bill to coordinate with the Secretary of Health and Safety regarding distribution for the advertisement of these offerings by posting flyers across campus, (including graduate schools), and placing the A-frame posters in front of Sadler Center and Campus Center.
5. Charges sponsors and supporters of the bill to table in front of Sadler with the purpose of passing out flyers, cards, and stickers
  - a. Date: TBD
6. Encourages members of the Student Assembly to actively promote and educate the student body of free flu vaccination availability at the Student Health Center, and to share all related online graphics via members' social media accounts.
7. Stipulates all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
