The Sustainability Fair Act

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by President Yannie Chang ('25), Senator Hazel Vincet ('25), Senator Matthew Hwang ('25)

WHEREAS, the mission of this event is to educate and bring awareness to the campus community about sustainability, while uplifting the work of sustainability and environmental student organizations on campus;

WHEREAS, the fair will be comprised of sustainability focused events;

WHEREAS, To promote widespread campus involvement and elevate the ongoing work of existing sustainability and environmental organizations - related student organizations, departments, and offices have been invited by the Department of Sustainability to sponsor tables and activities;

WHEREAS, there is intent to invite: IIC, W&M Sustainability, Botany Club, SUSTAIN, Dining Sustainability, Tribe Adventure Program, Veggie Society, SEAC, Sunrise Movement, Food for All, Student Environmental & Animal Law Society, Geology Club, Marine Science Society, Parks and Ecotherapy Research Lab, Bird Club, Matoaka Bottom Feeders, Citizens Climate Lobby, and the Environmental Humanities Hub.

WHEREAS, to promote the mission, all activities, crafts, and food are focused around sustainability;

WHEREAS, the Sustainability Fair will be tentatively held on November 3rd, 3-5pm at the Crim Dell Meadows.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocate \$2,605 from the Student Assembly Reserves to pay for:
 - a. Flyers (\$20)

- b. Furniture (\$380)
 - c. Vegan Food and Drink(\$1500)
 - i. plant-based cookies
 - ii. Water + lemonade
 - d. AV (\$200)
2. Charges the members of the Senate of Student Assembly to promote this event through social media, i.e. instagram, as well as charging Class Presidents with advertising this event in class emails.
 3. Stipulates that all unused funds go back to the Student Assembly Reserves.
