The Portable Chargers Act

WHEREAS, most William and Mary students have a cell phone that they carry with them throughout the day;

WHEREAS, cell phones have a limited battery life;

WHEREAS, as the William and Mary Police Department is transitioning away from static e-phone kiosks (Blue Lights) to the Rave Guardian App students it is important that students are able to keep their phones charged;

WHEREAS, the Bee McLeod Recreation Center and the Wellness Center are popular student centers;

WHEREAS, the Recreation Center staff and the Wellness Ambassadors are willing and able to store and lend out phone chargers to students in need.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates up to \$190 from the Student Assembly Reserves to fund the following:
 - a. 4 3-count iPhone fast chargers at \$103.60 (\$25.90 each)
 - b. 6 2-count USB-C chargers at \$77.94 (\$12.99 each)
2. Charges the sponsor of this bill to work in tandem with the Recreation Center and the Wellness Center and oversee this program and upkeep the stock of chargers.
3. Stipulates that all unused funds will return to the Student Assembly Reserves.
